

2025 APPLICATION PACKET

GENERAL RULES

- 1. A contestant in the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant must be a winner of a pageant held by a fair, which is a member in good standing of the Illinois Association of Agricultural Fairs. A runner-up in the same contest may compete in the state pageant if the Queen cannot attend.
- 2. Former County Fair Queens are not eligible to participate in the State Pageant.
- 3. Personal Characteristics: In order to be eligible, contestants must certify the personal characteristics in this section.
 - a. Must be a minimum of 16 years of age and have yet to reach her 22nd birthday by January 1, 2025.
 - b. Must be a U.S. Citizen. The contestant, parent, or legal guardian must be an Illinois resident for at least six months
 - c. Can never have been convicted of a felony offense.
 - d. Was born a female and have always been a female. Marital status must be single and never have been married or had a marriage annulled.
 - e. Can never have been pregnant.
 - f. Does not use or consume any illegal controlled substances or abuse the use of alcohol or other dangerous substances.
 - g. Is of good moral character. Has never performed any act or engaged in any activity or employment that is or could be characterized as immoral or indecent. Attests that any online depictions associated with the contestant's name or likeness including but not limited to Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Snapchat, and any other social media outlet pages are consistent with the standards and dignity of the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant.
- 4. It is understood that the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant name, crest, and website are the sole property of the IAAF/Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant Association. No person associated or not associated with a fair or fair queen pageant is authorized to utilize the crest or name, in part or entirety, in any type of publication, or maintain a link to the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen website without the express written permission of the IAAF's Pageant Director.
- 5. The application deadline is detailed below. Complete the application according to the instructions/checklist.
- 6. If we do not receive your application on or before the deadline, your fair secretary, President of the IAAF, and the Pageant Committee Chair will be notified. If the application is not received on or before the deadline, the contestant will not compete in the State Pageant. If the 8" x 10" photograph is not received, it will not appear on the display boards at the convention. If the wallet-size photo is not received, it will not be included in the pageant program or the Judges Information Sheet. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE DEADLINES.
 - a. If your pageant is in June, July, or August your deadline is October 1st, 2024.
 - b. If your pageant is in September your deadline is October 20, 2024.
- 7. Application to the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant authorizes the use of the contestant's name, likeness in pictures, physical depiction, endorsement rights, and titles by the IAAF or its subsidiaries, or by such persons, firms, or corporations as may be approved or selected by the IAAF.
- All contestants must be checked in at the registration desk on the first floor by <u>11:00 a.m. on Thursday</u>, <u>January 16, 2025</u>. IAAF officials will reserve rooms for the Queen and her chaperone only. Payment arrangements need to be made in advance between the responsible party and the hotel.

- 9. Each fair must always provide a chaperone to their Queen contestant during the convention and pageant activities.
- 10. The IAAF/Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant organization shall determine the time, manner, and method of conducting the competition. Each contestant must arrange her personal schedule as she is expected to attend all pageant activities.
 - a. The pageant will be a four-day event beginning, Thursday, January 16th, 2025, and ending at the reception following the coronation of our new Queen on Sunday, January 19th, 2025.
 - b. The competition will include the contestant's personal interview with judges, appearances in an evening gown, a one-piece swimsuit, and a speech presentation on stage.
- 11. If selected as Miss Illinois County Fair Queen 2025, the Queen will serve as hostess of the 2025 Illinois State Fair and DuQuoin State Fair, visit county fairs throughout the summer, and participate in other events arranged by the State Pageant Director during the year. She agrees not to enter any pageant during her reign as Miss Illinois County Fair Queen.
- 12. In the event of her marriage or any other reason that would keep her from fulfilling her obligations as Miss Illinois County Fair Queen 2025, the Queen will relinquish her title, crown, privileges, and all gifts, and be succeeded by the first runner-up.
- 13. The decision of the judges is final. Any grievances or objections relative to the contest will be referred to the Queen Committee of the IAAF.

Complete instructions concerning dates and general information will be emailed to each contestant and her director.

2025 Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant Checklist and Instructions

PLEASE FOLLOW THIS CHECKLIST TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE MET ALL OF THE NECESSARY REQUIREMENTS

• COMPLETE THE APPLICATION COMPLETELY

The contestant application for the Miss Illinois County Fair Queen Pageant must be completed and emailed to the following address pageantdirector@illinoisfairs.com.

<u>Use only current information - from high school years forward.</u> The judges do not need to hear your life story. Do not include what happened to you in elementary school or jr high unless it relates to your career plans or was an extremely important event.

Be Brief: The judges have limited time to read your application. Short phrases are easier to read than sentences and paragraphs. Eliminate "I was in high school chorus for four years, was selected to IMEA District Choir my junior and senior year, and was the Choreographer for or Show Choir. **Instead, do this**: List "Choir; Show Choir Choreographer" under **Activities** and put IMEA District Choir under **Special Honors**. How long you have participated is not important. The listing enables the judges to spot what they are looking for when they interview you. When completing the application, list your most recent activities first; college, then high school, then extracurricular.

<u>Check your spelling</u>: Judges will see this application as you have completed it. Confidential information will not be shared with the judges.

• UPLOAD THE FOLLOWING PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC MATERIAL:

Both photographs must be emailed to pageantdirector@illinoisfairs.com Your photographs must be a minimum of 300 dpi and <u>submitted as JPEG or EPS file</u>.

Must be studio photos with a plain background, NO OUTDOOR PHOTOS. Give this information to your photographer and they will be able to provide you with these files in the appropriate resolution and dimensions. Photos will **NOT** be accepted if they do not follow these guidelines.

▶ UPLOAD THE FOLLOWING PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHIC MATERIAL:

Please note the new requirement changes for the formal gown with crown photograph.

BUSINESS HEADSHOT PHOTO

- Wallet size photograph 2 1/4" wide x 3 1/4" tall; length between forehead and chin must be 1 1/4".
- Head and shoulders
- Attire: Business dress or suit without crown and sash
- Light gray or light blue plain background only. Photos of other background colors will NOT be accepted. Darker colors may blend with hair color and white will blend with the page around it.
- Make sure there is a distinction between your hair color and your clothing, for example: if you have dark hair, don't wear a dark color.
- This photo will be printed on the application to be used for identification purposes by the Judges and used in the pageant program.
- Name this file your "(fair name) business". Example- Morgan Business.

■ FORMAL GOWN WITH CROWN PHOTO- Read carefully and adhere to the rules please!

To create a uniform look on the photo boards, please adhere to the following requirements.

• 8" x 10" size vertical studio portrait with a plain background, NO outdoor photos, and NO props.

• THIS PHOTO MUST BE FROM THE WAIST UP AND QUEEN MUST BE FORWARD FACING.

Please note: NO full length, NO 3/4 length, NO head and shoulders, NO close-up photos and NO over the shoulder poses will be accepted.

• Attire: EVENING GOWN WITH CROWN ON THE HEAD AND WEARING SASH ACROSS

THE BODY IN A TRADITIONAL MANNER. Other regalia, such as scepter, is optional.

- This photo will be displayed during the IAAF Convention.
- Name this file your "(fair name) gown". Example- Morgan Gown.




Here are a few helpful advertising tips:
